

**East Rockhill Township Board of Supervisors**

**November 18, 2014**

**Regular Business Meeting Minutes**

The regular business meeting of the East Rockhill Township Board of Supervisors was held at 7:00p.m. on November 18, 2014 in the Township meeting room at the East Rockhill Township Municipal Building, 1622 North Ridge Road, Perkasie, PA 18944.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00p.m. by Mr. Nyman with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Approval of Minutes from October Regular Meeting**

**On motion** by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nyman, to adopt the meeting minutes from the Board of Supervisors' October 21, 2014 Regular Meeting. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

**Payment of the Bills**

- Assistant Scout Leader Tom Suchy and four boy scouts were present from Boy Scout Troop 1 Sellersville working on a Government Merit Badge.
- Greg Banis, Overhill Circle, supports Pennridge Regional Police Department providing coverage 24/7. He questioned why the Pennridge Yellowjacket have to pay to reserve fields for travel soccer practice.
- Zach Law, West Rock Road, expressed concern that the calls for service only hours by the Pennridge Regional Police and State Police coverage has received such lengthy coverage in the local newspapers.
- Dave Perkins, Doylestown, asked for clarification regarding East Rockhill Township contributing 45% of Pennridge Regional Police Department budget and the calls for service indicates 40% is received.

**Township Manager's Report: Marianne Morano**

**UCC Appeal Application:** The Pennridge School District is seeking relief from the Building Code requirements for toilet facilities with the construction of bleachers and concession stand. The Board did not have any concerns.

**Resignation of Zoning Hearing Member:** Notice was received by from Stephen C. Yates, 140 Bridgeview Drive, that he would be relocating out of the Township in the Spring of 2015 and therefore will need to resign his position on the Zoning Hearing Board.
