PARK & RECREATION BOARD NOTES

August 27, 2013

The East Rockhill Township Park and Recreation Board met for their first meeting since March 23, 2010 on August 27, 2013, 7:00pm, at the East Rockhill Township Municipal Building, 1622 North Ridge Road, Perkasio, PA 18944. The following members were present:

Reorganization. A motion was made to nominate Diane Blodgett as Chairperson, Patricia Marlin as Vice-Chairperson, all were in favor. Secretary position remains vacant.

The Board recognized Kevin Kochanski's resignation due to relocating out of East Rockhill Township.

Introduction of Vacancy Applicant. Mr. Jake Grogan was present to introduce himself as an applicant to the Park and Recreation Board vacancy. There is a second applicant for consideration who could not attend the meeting.

Mrs. Morano reviewed with the Board East Rockhill Township open space and park and recreation activities since the last meeting.

Purchase of 18.05 acres at 1510 Ridge Road which join the Markey Centennial Park to the Municipal Complex. Five acres were purchased with general fund monies for possible future municipal use. The Board would like to walk the property at the next meeting.

Conservation Easement on 31 acres at 1310 West Rock Road.

Walking trail was completed in 2012 along Three Mile Run Road by Perkasio Regional Authority. A continuation of the path will cross Three Mile Run Road, up Schoolhouse Road, into Markey Centennial Park.

An Eagle Scout has committed to building and installing bat houses and improving the nature trail at Markey Centennial Park. Mrs. Blodgett requested a sign marking the nature trail be added to the project. The Board agreed.
