The East Rockhill Township Park and Recreation Board met on August 26, 2014, 7:00pm, at the Willard H. Markey Centennial Park pavilion, 1418 North Ridge Road, Perkasio, PA 18944. The following members were present:

Recreation Update:

Mrs. Blodgett updated the Board on the PA Highland Trail Meeting. Extensive trail clean-up has been occurring in the Quakertown area.

Bucks County Covered Bridge Society assisted the Mood's family with a Mood's Family Reunion and public festival on June 7, 2014. A summary and pictures of the festival was distributed to the Board.

Future Capital Projects:

Mrs. Morano noted the 2015 preliminary budget is anticipated to have an upgrade to the Pines Playground. Mrs. Blodgett will be walking the site.

New Business:

Mrs. Brzezicki requested painting the pavilion picnic tables could be a future Eagle Scout project.

Old Business:

Purchase of two conservation easements have been completed that border current conservation easements. Ridge Road 10.48 acres maintaining the Ridge Road vista and Three Mile Run Road 8.338 acres preserving blue heron nesting and Three Mile Run Creek.

Park Activity Update:

A walking tour of Markey Park annexation 18.0426 acres took place. The property joins the Markey Park with the Municipal complex, five acres are reserved for future Township municipal use. The removal of the dwelling units is anticipated in the 2015 preliminary budget. Future plans for the property could be soccer fields or tennis courts. Mrs. Blodgett will provide names of contractors who may be willing to remove the house tenant abandoned personal property at no charge.
