PARK & RECREATION BOARD NOTES

February 24, 2015

The East Rockhill Township Park and Recreation Board met for their first meeting in 2015 on February 24, 2015, 7:00pm, at the East Rockhill Township Municipal Building, 1622 North Ridge Road, Perkasie, PA 18944. The following members were present:

Reorganization. A motion was made to nominate Diane Blodgett as Chairperson, Patricia Marlin as Vice-Chairperson, Anne Fenley as Secretary position, all were in favor.

The August 26, 2014 meeting notes were noted as received and approved.

Park Activity Update:

Pennridge Greenjacket lease was renewed for 2015 through 2019 with no notable changes.

Mrs. Morano walked the newly annexed Moore property adjacent to the Willard H. Markey Centennial Park with 2014 Pennridge Yellowjackets travel coordinator representatives as a possible location to build soccer fields and execute a lease with the Township.

Recreation Update:

PA Highland Trail Network Meeting: A representative would like to walk the East Rockhill Township existing trails.

Trail Easement: Supervisor Nyman and Mrs. Morano attended a Pennridge School District Finance Committee meeting to present partnering on a DCED grant opportunity for the trail from Pennridge High School to Willard H. Markey Centennial Park on an existing easement. It is being reviewed during their budget process.

Future Capital Projects:

Markey Park annexation house was demolished, grading and seeding will occur when the weather permits.

New Business:

- Mr. Stevens commented the Township website links on the Park and Rec page need updating, a park patron was filling water jugs at Markey Park and website indicates 87 acres on Three Mile Run Road is available to the public but he observed no trespassing signs. The property along Three Mile Run Road with the walking trail belongs to Perkasie Regional Authority.
- Mrs. Brzezicki questioned if downed trees on state owned lands could be cleaned up. She will follow up with Nockamixon State Park.
