The regular business meeting of the Pennridge Regional Police Commission was held at 7:00pm on February 22, 2017 in the meeting room at the Pennridge Regional Police Headquarters, 200 Ridge Road, Sellersville, PA 18960.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Mr. Keyser with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Keyser then advised that on January 25, 2017 and February 15, 2017, the Commission met in executive session to discuss real estate matters.

Announcements

Distinguished Service Award was presented to Officer Forbes for administering Naloxone to a victim suffering from a heroin overdose. Chief Blake noted that it was Officer Forbes' quick action that saved the subjects life.

Approval of Minutes from January 25, 2017 Regular Meeting

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Miller, to adopt the meeting minutes from the Pennridge Regional Police Commission's January 25, 2017 Regular Meeting. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Financial Report: Chief Blake

Chief Blake read the financial report dated February 22, 2017. After payment of the monthly bills totaling \$43,494.25 the total operational account balances equal \$102,698.79. The cash reserve account funds total \$345,631.24.

On motion by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to approve payment of Bills List dated February 22, 2017 totaling \$43,494.25 and the Financial Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Chief's Report: Chief Blake

Chief Blake read the monthly report indicating Department activities for the month of January 2017. The report is on file.

On motion by Mr. Keyser, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to approve the Chief's Report as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Solicitors Report: John B. Rice, Esq.

Mr. Keyser added that there would be an executive session following the meeting to discuss real estate matters.

Old Business

Mr. Volovnik commented that the flag pole lights had been installed and looked good. Mr. Keyser also mentioned that the parking lights had been fixed.

Mr. Miller mentioned that the storm water pipe issue at police headquarters had been discussed at the East Rockhill Meeting and that both Township Maintenance Crews would be working together on the project.

New Business

2018 Budget.

Chief Blake advised the Commission that the Public Safety Committee has already begun to look at the 2018 Budget, anticipating that some numbers would be given to the Board in May.

Mr. Keyser asked if the new car was in service yet. Chief Blake advised that it should be on the street within 2 to 3 weeks.

Citizen Comment #2:

- Mr. Jim Nietupski, East Rockhill Supervisor, asked if the "Police Support" signs had been ordered. Chief Blake advised that Officer Ruiz had ordered the signs.
