**Pollution Reduction Plan / MS4 Stormwater:** Stormwater Permit submission to PA Department of Environmental Protection per Federal Clean Water National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System, PA Clean Streams Law and the PADEP issued Municipal Separate Stormwater Sewer System Permit for municipalities in watersheds with Pollution Reduction Plan requirements has been advertised with a 30-day public comment period ending August 30, 2017. Residents who own basins were sent written notification of the plan. No comments were received.

**On motion** by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to adopt the Pollution Reduction Plan as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

**On motion** by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to authorize the Notice of Intent and documents be forwarded to Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

**New or Other Business**

- Mr. Nietupski asked for an update to tree trimming in Markey Park. The Contractor anticipates the work being completed in two weeks, Airport has approved two trees on their property being dropped onto Airport property which they will clean up at the same time they are cleaning up berm. The Township will pay the Contractor for all work.

- Bob Keeler, Reporter, questioned the percentage of sediment reduction. The requirement is ten percent.
