Public Comment #1:

Approval of Minutes and Bills Payable:

Approval of Minutes.

On motion by Mr. Nyman, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to approve the meeting minutes from the Board of Supervisors March 26, 2024 Regular Meeting as presented. Mr. Nietupski withdrew a request for an amendment. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Approval of Bills Payable.

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to approve payment of the Bills List dated April 19, 2024 for a total amount of \$282,751.53 as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Board and Commission Reports:

Penridge Regional Police Department: Chief Dickinson

The Chief shared the March 2024 Penridge Regional Police activity report.

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to accept the Penridge Regional Police Department report. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Planning Commission: Marianne Hart Morano

The April 11, 2024 agenda and draft minutes were provided to the Board. Mrs. Morano stated 400 Branch Road land development and waivers were reviewed and recommended for preliminary approval.

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to accept the Planning Commission report. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Pennridge Wastewater Treatment Authority: Dave Nyman

The March 2024 minutes and flow reports were provided to the Board. Mr. Nyman participated by phone. He noted there is still not agreement among all the member municipalities regarding recertification renewal.

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to accept the Pennridge Wastewater Treatment Authority report. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Pennridge Area Coordinating Committee: Gary Volovnik

The March 28, 2024 minutes were provided to the Board.

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to accept the Pennridge Area Coordinating Committee report. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Township Manager's Report: Marianne Hart Morano

Zoning Hearing Board Application 935 Three Mile Run Road. Mr. Steve Piccari and Mrs. Susan Piccari were present to answer questions regarding requested special exception to change from a non-conforming F-27 Automobile Repair Shop to a non-conforming B-9 Residential Conversion in the Suburban Zoning District at 935 Three Mile Run Road. The Zoning Hearing Board application and supporting documentation were provided to the Board.

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to take a neutral position on the Zoning Hearing Board application as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Pennridge Regional Police Department 2024 Budget.

On motion by Mr. Nyman, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to follow the 2024 adopted budget to hire a Patrol Officer. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Public Works Report: Jeff Scholl

Mr. Scholl updated the Board on Public Works activities as of April 18, 2024.

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to approve the Township Public Works report. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Township Engineer Report: Steve Baluh, P.E.

Consideration of Preliminary Land Development submission at 400 Branch Road, tax map parcel 12-013-008, for a 6,600 square feet addition located in the Commercial Office Zoning District. Mr. Larry Byrne, P.E. and Mr. Shane Dam were present. Lighting is to be 20 feet in height and a crosswalk continues to be under review.

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to grant preliminary land development approval at 400 Branch Road contingent on compliance with Wynn Associates April 8, 2024 correspondence and concurrence with Planning Commission waiver request recommendations as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Renew Bible Church located at 1600 N. Fifth Street emergency exit for Renew Bible Church located at 1600 N. Fifth Street. Mr. Greg Landis, Mr. Scott Mease, P.E. and Mr. Dave Artman were present on behalf of the applicant. Mr. Steve Gozur, Traffic Planning and Design was present.

Consensus of the Board was to have a 12 feet wide emergency road, either stone or grass geo-blocks, to allow emergency exit of vehicles from the facility.

Stone Edge Culvert Traffic Planning and Design submitted a proposal for initial services to determine reasonable alternatives to accommodate flooding concerns at Stone Edge culvert was provided to the Board. John Liberaotre, P.E., Traffic Planning & Design was present. Survey work is not included in the scope of work. Expenses are to be paid from Capital Reserve Stone Edge Road allocation.

- Jim Snyder, 45 Stone Edge Road, asked if the train bridge should be looked at first to determine if that will always cause flooding at the culvert.

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to accept Traffic Planning and Design Proposal dated March 25, 2024 in the amount of \$38,080.00 as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Township Solicitor Report: Will Oetinger, Esq.

Conditional Use Adjudication for Perkasio Regional Authority for the expansion of a G1 Utilities Use to add water filtration and treatment facilities at 730 Three Mile Run Road tax map parcel 12-009-009.

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, approve the adjudication as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Three Mile Run Road and Old Bethlehem Road Reclassification Draft Ordinance

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to authorize the Planning Commissions review and subsequent advertisement of the draft Ordinance unless there is substantive changes to reclassify Three Mile Run Road east of SR313 and Old Bethlehem Road minor collector road to local access road as presented. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

On motion by Mr. Volovnik, seconded by Mr. Nietupski, to approve the Township Solicitor report. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

Department and Emergency Services Reports:

On motion by Mr. Nietupski, seconded by Mr. Volovnik, to acknowledge receipt of the Department and Emergency Services reports. With no additional discussion, all present voted in favor.

New or Other Business Supervisors' Items:

- Mr. Nietupski stated he voted in opposition of a resolution that would have supported legislation to eliminate the elected tax collector position at the annual PSATS convention.
- Executive Session will take place following tonight's meeting for real estate.

Public Comment #2:

- Chuck Weaver, 47 Ridge Run Road, stated he does not want to lose the ability to drive over Stone Edge culvert during possible construction.
- Jennifer Wright, 400 Three Mile Run Road, stated continued concerns regarding PFAS contamination levels.
- Mark Ezzo, 2901 Hill Road, stated water quality concerns.

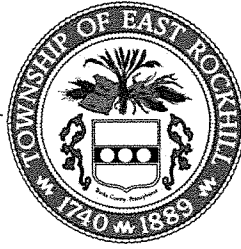

WHEREAS, a Local Government Records Committee was created by Act 428 of 1968 and empowered thereby to make rules and regulations for records disposition; and ,

WHEREAS, the Municipal Records Manual was approved by said Committee December 16, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, East Rockhill Township desires to dispose of records according to statutory requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of East Rockhill Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, that it intends to follow the schedules and procedures of records as set forth in the Municipal Records Manual approved on December 16, 2008, as amended on March 28, 2019.

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ARTICLES OF
AMENDMENT TO INCREASE THE TERM OF
EXISTENCE OF THE PENNRIDGE WASTEWATER
TREATMENT AUTHORITY FOR FIFTY (50) YEARS.**

WHEREAS, the municipality of _____ (the “Municipality”) is a member of the Pennridge Wastewater Treatment Authority (“PWTA”), which treats all or a certain portion of the Municipality’s sanitary sewage; and

WHEREAS, the PWTA is a municipality authority subject to the Pennsylvania Municipal Authorities Act, 53 Pa.C.S.A. §5601, *et seq.* (the “Act”) comprised of six (6) member municipalities, being: (i) Borough of Perkasio, Bucks County; (ii) Borough of Sellersville, Bucks County; (iii) Borough of Silverdale, Bucks County; (iv) East Rockhill Township, Bucks County; (v) Hilltown Township, Bucks County; and (vi) Borough of Telford, Bucks and Montgomery Counties (collectively the “Member Municipalities”); and

WHEREAS, the PWTA was created by Articles of Incorporation dated March 20, 1973, and modified by a Certificate of Joinder accepted on May 24, 1976 (collectively, the “Articles of Incorporation”), which operates pursuant to the Pennridge Wastewater Treatment Authority Treatment Plan Agreement dated November 1, 1975 (the “1975 Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5605(a)(1) of the Act, the Articles of Incorporation of the PWTA must be amended no less than every fifty (50) years in order to allow the PWTA’s term of existence to be extended; and

WHEREAS, the PWTA, in accordance with Section 5605(b) of the Act, prepared and provided to the Municipality recommended draft articles of amendment, which are attached hereto as Exhibit “A” (the “Articles of Amendment”); and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Municipality believes it in the best interest of the Municipality to adopt the Articles of Amendment as proposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the _____ of the municipality of _____, as follows:

SECTION I. – Adoption of the Articles of Amendment

In accordance with Section 5605 of the Pennsylvania Municipal Authorities Act, 53 Pa.C.S.A. §5601, *et seq.*, the Municipality hereby adopts the Articles of Amendment attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and directs the manager of the Municipality to provide notice of the same to the PWTA and to take any such other action as needed to assist the PWTA with the completion, finalization and filing thereof.

SECTION II. – Severability

The provisions of this Resolution are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part or provision hereof shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts or provisions of this Resolution. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the governing body of the Municipality that this Resolution would have been adopted even if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part or provision had not been included herein.

SECTION III. – Failure to Enforce not a Waiver

The failure to enforce any provision of this Resolution shall not constitute a waiver by the Municipality of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION IV. – Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its approval as required by the law.

SECTION V. – Repealer

All other resolutions or parts thereof insofar as they are inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed.
