Headquarter Heating and Cooling System Update:

Four companies had been contacted to have an evaluation of the Geothermal heating/cooling system and of those four companies, two had provided further steps for the department to take in regard to evaluating the system to ensure proper operation.

Members of the commission and public expressed the need to follow up with two local companies to conduct an evaluation and have the Chief and both township managers' report back to the commission at the March meeting.
